Isaiah 9:6 - For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Pil-iy (pi-lee)- Too wonderful for words.

Ya'ats - To advise, to counsel, to guide; it denotes one of honorable rank; one who is suited to stand near princes and kings as their adviser. It is expressive of great wisdom, and of qualifications to guide and direct the human race.

I. He knows you.

Hebrews 4:15 (HCSB) – “For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tested in every way as we are, yet without sin.”

(NLT) - “This High Priest of ours understands our weaknesses, for he faced all of the same testings we do, yet he did not sin”.

(NCV) - “For our high priest is able to understand our weaknesses. When he lived on earth, he was tempted in every way that we are, but he did not sin”.

II. He cares about you.

1 Peter 5:7 (CEV) – “God cares for you, so turn all your worries over to Him.”

(NLT) - “Give all your worries and cares to God, for he cares about you”.

III. He is committed to you.

John 10:27-28

27 "My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me.

28 And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand."

Romans 8:38-39

38 For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come,

39 nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord."

1. Be brutally honest with the Counselor.

Psalm 55:22 – "Cast you cares on the Lord and He will sustain you; He will never let the righteous fall."

(MSG) - "Pile your troubles on God's shoulders — he'll carry your load, he'll help you out. He'll never let good people topple into ruin".

2. Listen to the Counselor's voice.

Mark 9:7 (NLT) – "Then a cloud overshadowed them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my dearly loved Son. Listen to him".

Through The BIBLE

Psalm 119:105 - "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path."

Though the HOLY SPIRIT

Look at what it says in John chapter sixteen:

John 16:13 (HCSB) - "When the Spirit of truth comes, He will guide you into all the truth."

He speaks through GODLY COUNSEL

Proverbs 15:22 (MSG) "Refuse good advice and watch your plans fail; take good counsel and watch them succeed."

3. Do what the Counselor tells you to do.

John 10:27 – "My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me."

James 1:22- "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves."

(NLT) "But don't just listen to God's word. You must do what it says. Otherwise, you are only fooling yourselves".
