A Little Compromise Brings A Lot Of Trouble!

Genesis12:1-5

- 1 The LORD had said to Abram, "Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you.
- 2 "I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing.
- 3 I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you."
- 4 So Abram went, as the LORD had told him; and Lot went with him. Abram was seventy-five years old when he set out from Harran.
- 5 He took his wife Sarai, his nephew Lot, all the possessions they had accumulated and the people they had acquired in Harran, and they set out for the land of Canaan, and they arrived there.
- 1. He must leave his country and kindred = relatives, and his father's house.
- 2. He must follow with no knowledge of where he is going.

Acts 27:25 - "... I have faith in God that it will happen just as he told me."

Num. 23:19 - God is not human, that he should lie, not a human being, that he should change his mind. Does he speak and then not act? Does he promise and not fulfill?

Genesis12: 7-8

7 The LORD appeared to Abram and said, "To your offspring I will give this land." So he built an altar there to the LORD, who had appeared to him. 8 From there he went on toward the hills east of Bethel and pitched his tent, with Bethel on the west and Ai on the east. There he built an altar to the LORD and called on the name of the LORD.

Gen. 13:14-16

- 14 The LORD said to Abram <u>after Lot had parted from him</u>, "Look around from where you are, to the north and south, to the east and west.
- 15 All the land that you see I will give to you and your offspring forever.
- 16 I will make your offspring like the dust of the earth, so that if anyone could count the dust, then your offspring could be counted.
- 1Cor. 2:9 However, as it is written: "What no eye has seen, what no ear has

heard, and what no human mind has conceived" the things God has prepared for those who love him

Lot Means = veil

Gal. 5:24 - Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

Rom. 8:13 - For if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live.

Col. 3:5 - Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry.
