Are You A Christian Who Makes The Devil Nervous?

Acts 19:13-17

- 13. Some Jews who went around driving out evil spirits tried to invoke the name of the Lord Jesus over those who were demonpossessed. They would say, "In the name of Jesus, whom Paul preaches, I command you to come out."
- 14. Seven sons of Sceva, a Jewish chief priest, were doing this.
- 15. [One day] the evil spirit answered them, "Jesus I know, and I know about Paul, but who are you?"
- 16. Then the man who had the evil spirit jumped on them and overpowered them all. He gave them such a beating that they ran out of the house naked and bleeding.
- 17. When this became known to the Jews and Greeks living in Ephesus, they were all seized with fear, and the name of the Lord Jesus was held in high honor.

Isaiah 14:12-15,

- 12. How you have fallen from heaven, O morning star, son of the dawn! You have been cast down to the earth, you who once laid low the nations!
- 13. You said in your heart, "I will ascend to heaven; I will raise my throne above the stars of God; I will sit enthroned on the mount of assembly, on the utmost heights of the sacred mountain.
- 14. I will ascend above the tops of the clouds; I will make myself like the Most High."
- 15. But you are brought down to the grave, to the depths of the pit.
- Rev. 12:9 The great dragon was hurled down--that ancient serpent called the devil, or Satan, who leads the whole world astray. He was hurled to the earth, and his angels with him.
- I Peter 5:8, Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.
- John 8:44, You belong to your father, the devil, and you want to

carry out your father's desire. He was a murderer from the beginning, not holding to the truth, for there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the father of lies.

Rev. 20:10, And the devil, who deceived them, was thrown into the lake of burning sulfur, where the beast and the false prophet had been thrown. They will be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

1. Surrendered Christians make the devil nervous!

Mt. 16:24 - Then Jesus said to his disciples, "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me.

2. Praying Christians make the devil nervous!

Eph. 6:18-19 - And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints. Pray also for me, that whenever I open my mouth, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel,

3. Forgiving Christians make the devil nervous!

Col.3:13 - Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.

Matt. 6:9-15 - After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen. For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly

Father will also forgive you: But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

4. United Christians make the devil nervous!

I Cor.1:10 - I appeal to you, brothers, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another so that there may be no divisions among you and that you may be perfectly united in mind and thought.

Col. 2:2-3 - My purpose is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, Christ, in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

Phil. 2:1-8

- 1. If you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any fellowship with the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion,
- 2. then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and purpose.
- 3. Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves.
- 4. Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others.
- 5. Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus:
- 6. Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped,
- 7. but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.
- 8. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death-- even death on a cross!

5. Christians who know their destiny make the devil nervous!

Rom. 8:29-32

- 29. For those God foreknew he also <u>predestined</u> to be conformed to the likeness of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers.
- 30. And those he <u>predestined</u>, he also called; those he called, he also justified; those he justified, he also glorified.
- 31. What, then, shall we say in response to this? If God is for us, who can be against us?
- 32. He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all--how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?

Eph.1:3-14

- 3. Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ.
- 4. For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. In love
- 5. He <u>predestined</u> us to be adopted as his sons through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will--
- 6. to the praise of his glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One he loves.
- 7. In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace
- 8. that he lavished on us with all wisdom and understanding.
- 9. And he made known to us the mystery of his will according to his good pleasure, which he purposed in Christ,
- 10. to be put into effect when the times will have reached their fulfillment--to bring all things in heaven and on earth together under one head, even Christ.
- 11. In him we were also chosen, having been <u>predestined</u> according to the plan of him who works out everything in conformity with the purpose of his will,
- 12. in order that we, who were the first to hope in Christ, might be for the praise of his glory.
- 13. And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit,

- 14. who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession--to the praise of his glory.
- Mt. 7:21-23 "Not everyone who says to me, `Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. Many will say to me on that day, `Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and in your name drive out demons and perform many miracles?' Then I will tell them plainly, <u>`I never knew you</u>. Away from me, you evildoers!'
