## At The Edge Of A Healing

Numbers 23:19 - God is not a man, that he should lie, nor a son of man, that he should change his mind. Does he speak and then not act? Does he promise and not fulfill?

Numbers 23:19 (CEV) - "God is no mere human! He doesn't tell lies or change his mind.

Romans 10:17 - "Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God"

Psalm 107:20 - "He sent forth his word and healed them..."

II Kings 2:21 – Then he went out to the spring and threw the salt into it, saying, "This is what the LORD says: `I have healed this water. Never again will it cause death or make the land unproductive."

Healed = Rapha - cure, (cause to) heal, physician, repair, X thoroughly, make whole.

II Kings 2:22: And the water has remained wholesome (rapha - healed) to this day, according to the word Elisha had spoken.

Psalm 107:20 – He sent forth his word and healed them; he rescued them from the grave.

NKJV - "He sent His word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions."

Mt. 8:2-3 - A man with leprosy came and knelt before him and said, "Lord, if you are willing, you can make me clean." Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. "I am willing," he said. "Be clean!" Immediately he was cured of his leprosy.

Isaiah 53:5 – But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace

was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed.

Matthew 4:23 – Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom, and <u>healing every disease and sickness among the people</u>.

Matthew 4:24 – News about him spread all over Syria, and people brought to him all who were ill with various diseases, those suffering severe pain, the demon-possessed, those having seizures, and the paralyzed, and he healed them.

Matthew 8:13 Then Jesus said to the centurion, "Go! It will be done just as you believed it would." And his servant was healed at that very hour.

Matthew 8:16 – When evening came, many who were demonpossessed were brought to him, and he drove out the spirits with a word and healed <u>all</u> the sick.

Matthew 12:22 – Then they brought him a demon-possessed man who was blind and mute, and Jesus healed him, so that he could both talk and see.

Matthew 9:35 Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom and healing <u>every</u> disease and sickness.

Mark 5:34 – He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace and be freed from your suffering."

Mark 6:5-6 – He could not do any miracles there, except lay his hands on a few sick people and heal them. And he was amazed at their lack of faith. Then Jesus went around teaching from village to village.

Luke 4:40 – When the sun was setting, the people brought to Jesus all who had various kinds of sickness, and laying his hands

on each one, he healed them.

Luke 9:11 – but the crowds learned about it and followed him. He welcomed them and spoke to them about the kingdom of God, and healed those who needed healing.

Acts 10:38 - how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power, and how he went around doing good and healing all who were under the power of the devil, because God was with him.

Mark 6:13 – They drove out many demons and anointed many sick people with oil and healed them.

Luke 9:6 – So they set out and went from village to village, preaching the gospel and healing people everywhere.

Acts 5:16 – Crowds gathered also from the towns around Jerusalem, bringing their sick and those tormented by evil spirits, and all of them were healed.

Acts 14:9-10 – He listened to Paul as he was speaking. Paul looked directly at him, saw that he had faith to be healed and called out, "Stand up on your feet!" At that, the man jumped up and began to walk.

Acts 28:8 – His (Publius) father was sick in bed, suffering from fever and dysentery. Paul went in to see him and, after prayer, placed his hands on him and healed him.

James 5:16 – Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective.

Proverbs 4:20-22 - My son, pay attention to what I say; listen closely to my words. Do not let them out of your sight, keep them within your heart; for they are life to those who find them and health to a man's whole body.

Matthew 9:2, ... "Take heart, son; your sins are forgiven."

Matthew 9:6, ... "Get up, take your mat and go home."

Psalm 103:3 ... "who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases"...

1 Peter 2:24 - "He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness;"

"Tis so sweet to trust in Jesus, Just to take Him AT HIS WORD; Just to rest upon His promise, Just to know THUS SAITH THE LORD."

Malachi 4:2 (NKJV) - But to you who fear My name the Sun of Righteousness shall arise with healing in His wings; and you shall go out and grow fat like stall-fed calves.

Malachi 4:2 (NIV) - But for you who revere my name, the Sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its rays. And you will go out and frolic like well-fed calves.

Wing, rays = Kanaph - skirt, corner, or loose flowing end, edge or hem of a garment.

## Matthew 9:20-22

20 Just then a woman who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years came up behind him and touched the edge (KJV-hem) of his cloak.

21 She said to herself, "If I only touch his cloak, I will be healed." 22 Jesus turned and saw her. "Take heart, daughter," he said, "your faith has healed you." And the woman was healed at that moment.

Matthew 9:35-38

- 35 Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness.
- 36 When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.
- 37 Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few.
- 38 Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field."

Matthew 10:1 - Jesus called his twelve disciples to him and gave them authority to drive out impure spirits and to heal every disease and sickness.
