- 2 Timothy 1:1-6 (ESV)
- 1 Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God according to the promise of the life that is in Christ Jesus,
- 2 To Timothy, my beloved child: Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.
- 3 I thank God whom I serve, as did my ancestors, with a clear conscience, as I remember you constantly in my prayers night and day.
- 4 As I remember your tears, I long to see you, that I may be filled with joy.
- 5 I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, dwells in you as well.
- 6 For this reason I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands,

KJV- "stir up the gift of God"

This Gift is the Holy Spirit and everything the Holy brings with him to your life!

It was Timothy's responsibility to keep the fire burning!

The most important thing that can happen in your life is to meet the Lord Jesus Christ!

Jesus said, "Except you be born again you cannot see the Kingdom of God!"

The next most important thing that can happen in your life is to be Baptized with the Holy Spirit and fire!

John said, "I baptize you with water unto repentance, but there's one coming

after me He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and Fire!"

Jesus said, "You shall receive Power after that the Holy Spirit is come upon you and you shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem and Judea and Samaria and unto the uttermost parts of the earth!"

Acts 2:1-4 (ESV)

- 1 When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place.
- 2 And suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting.
- 3 And divided tongues as of fire appeared to them and rested on each one of them.
- 4 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Why is this Holy Spirit and Fire so important?

Because the Holy Spirit is the supernatural power of God filling the human vessel in order to establish and advance the Kingdom of God in the earth!

What was the ministry of Jesus?

- 1. He came to seek and to save that which was lost!
- 2. He came to establish the Kingdom of God in the earth!
- 3. He came to destroy the works of the devil!

Acts 10:38 (ESV) - how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.

- 1 Jn. 3:8 (ESV) Whoever makes a practice of sinning is of the devil, for the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil.
- Heb. 13:8 (ESV) Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

Jesus ministry has never changed!

1Jn. 4:17 (ESV) - By this is love perfected with us, so that we may have confidence for the day of judgment, because as he is so also are we in this world.

The book of Acts is the diary and the record of the New Testament church in her infancy.

It is the record of the operation of the Holy Spirit through yielded vessels.

The book of Acts is the pattern for the New Testament Church.

We Need a Holy Spirit invasion!

Everything you need is in the Holy Spirit!

We must fan into flame and stir up the gift that is in us!

Wake up that calling!

Wake up that destiny!

Wake up that anointing!

Wake up that fire!

Peter carried that kind of fire!

They laid the sick and the diseased and the demon possessed in the streets and as his shadow passed over them they were healed delivered, and set free!

Paul had that Kind of fire!

So much so that even as people came into contact with handkerchiefs that had touched him, they were healed and delivered and set free!

Acts 19:11-12 (ESV)

11 And God was doing extraordinary miracles by the hands of Paul, 12 so that even handkerchiefs or aprons that had touched his skin were carried away to the sick, and their diseases left them and the evil spirits came out of them.

Timothy had that kind of fire!

History tells us that timothy became a great Apostle and Church planter who preached the Gospel in the face of great danger...

But was faithful to the end!

He literally laid his life down as a martyr to bring the Message of Jesus to the world around him!

YOU can have that SAME kind of Fire, that SAME kind of Anointing!

It was Timothy's Grandmother and Mother who got that whole thing started in his life!
