Going Up Higher!

Rev. 4:1 - After this I looked, and there before me was a door standing open in heaven. And the voice I had first heard speaking to me like a trumpet said, "Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after this."

2Cor. 3:18 - And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.

Pr 4:18 - The path of the righteous is like the first gleam of dawn, shining ever brighter till the full light of day.

Jn. 3:30 - He must increase, but I must decrease.

In Jn. 15:1-7 it is the life of progression from bringing forth fruit, to more fruit, to much fruit.

Gal. 2:20 - I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

1. You must set your sights higher!

2.Cor. 3:18a - And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory,

KJV – "Beholding as in a glass (mirror) the glory of the Lord."

1 Corinthians 3:3 - You are still worldly. For since there is jealousy and quarreling among you, are you not worldly? Are you not acting like mere humans?

Colossians 2:8 - See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the elemental spiritual forces of this world rather than on Christ.

Philosophy = wisdom of man

Col 3:2 Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.

KJV - Set your <u>affection</u> on things above, not on things on the earth.

2. You must be "All In"!

#1 Manifesting himself to us

#2 Manifesting himself in us

#3 Manifesting himself through us

Rom. 8:19 - The creation waits in eager expectation for the sons of God to be revealed.

KJV - For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God.

3. You must be able to hear the Lord's voice!

Revelation = What he is saying now for such a time as this.

4. You must begin walking in the fear of God again!

Joshua 3:1-5

1. Early in the morning Joshua and all the Israelites set out from Shittim and went to the Jordan, where they camped before crossing over.

2. After three days the officers went throughout the camp,

3. giving orders to the people: "When you see the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, and the priests, who are Levites, carrying it, you are to move out from your positions and follow it.

4. Then you will know which way to go, since you have never been this way before. But keep a distance of about a thousand yards between you and the ark; <u>do not go near it</u>."

5. Joshua told the people, "Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow <u>the LORD</u> <u>will do amazing things among you</u>."
