

It's Just Temporary!

2Co 4:15-18

15. All this is for your benefit, so that the grace that is reaching more and more people may cause thanksgiving to overflow to the glory of God.

16. Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day.

17. For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all.

18. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.

Deut 8:2-4

2. Remember how the LORD your God led you all the way in the desert these forty years, to humble you and to test you in order to know what was in your heart, whether or not you would keep his commands.

3. He humbled you, causing you to hunger and then feeding you with manna, which neither you nor your fathers had known, to teach you that man does not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of the LORD.

4. Your clothes did not wear out and your feet did not swell during these forty years.

Duet 8:15-16

15. He led you through the vast and dreadful desert, that thirsty and waterless land, with its venomous snakes and scorpions. He brought you water out of hard rock.

16. He gave you manna to eat in the desert, something your fathers had never known, to humble and to test you so that in the end it might go well with you.

Jn. 6:21 - Then they were willing to take him into the boat, and immediately the boat reached the shore where they were heading.

Mt. 8:3 - Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. "I am willing," he said. "Be clean!" Immediately he was cured of his leprosy.

Mt. 20:34 - Jesus had compassion on them and touched their eyes. Immediately they received their sight and followed him.

Mk. 5:29 - Immediately her bleeding stopped and she felt in her body that she was freed from her suffering.

Mk. 5:42 - Immediately the girl stood up and walked around (she was twelve years old). At this they were completely astonished.

Lk. 13:13 - Then he put his hands on her, and immediately she straightened up and praised God.

Mt. 14:31 - Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?"

Ps. 30:5 - weeping may remain for a night, but rejoicing comes in the morning.

Ps. 34:19 - A righteous man may have many troubles, but the LORD delivers him from them all;

Romans 8:28 - And we know that all things work together for good to them that love the Lord and are the called according to his purpose.
