Living A Life Worthy Of The Lord

Colossians 1:9-14

- 9. For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you and asking God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding.
- 10. And we pray this in order that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and may please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God,
- 11. being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience, and joyfully
- 12. giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in the kingdom of light.
- 13. For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves,
- 14. in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

Philippians 1:27 - Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ. Then, whether I come and see you or only hear about you in my absence, I will know that you stand firm in the one Spirit, striving together as one for the faith of the gospel

2 Thessalonians 1:11 - With this in mind, we constantly pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of his calling, and that by his power he may bring to fruition your every desire for goodness and your every deed prompted by faith.

Ephesians 4:1 [Unity and Maturity in the Body of Christ] As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received.

2 Corinthians 13:5 - Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves. Do you not realize that Christ Jesus is in you—unless, of course, you fail the test?

I. It's a life that is bearing fruit in every good work!

Matt. 7:15-17 - "Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ferocious wolves. By their fruit you will recognize them. Do people pick grapes from thornbushes, or figs from

thistles? Likewise every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit".

Galatians 5:16-26 (NLT) - "When you follow the desires of your sinful nature, your lives will produce these evil results: sexual immorality, impure thoughts, eagerness for lustful pleasure, idolatry, participation in demonic activities, hostility, quarreling, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambition, divisions, the feeling that everyone is wrong except those in your own little group, envy, drunkenness, wild parties, and other kinds of sin. Let me tell you again, as I have before, that anyone living that sort of life will not inherit the Kingdom of God. But when the Holy Spirit controls our lives, he will produce this kind of fruit in us: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Here there is no conflict with the law".

II. It's a life that is growing in the knowledge of God!

1 Cor. 8:1 - ...knowledge puffs up while love builds up.

III. It's a life that is being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might!

Luke 9:1 When Jesus had called the Twelve together, he gave them power and authority to drive out all demons and to cure diseases,

Luke 10:19 I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you.

Luke 24:49 I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high."

Acts 1:8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Acts 4:33 With great power the apostles continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And God's grace was so powerfully at work in them all

- 1 Corinthians 2:4 My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power,
- 1 Corinthians 4:20 For the kingdom of God is not a matter of talk but of power.

A life worthy of God is one that is filled with His power!

The fourth characteristic of a life worthy of the Lord is...

IV. It's a life that is joyfully giving thanks to the Father!

- 12. ...who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in the kingdom of light.
- 13. For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves,
- 14. in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

Heb. 13:20-21

- 20. May the God of peace, who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep,
- 21. equip you with everything good for doing his will, and may he work in us what is pleasing to him, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.
