

New Wine Calls For New Wineskins!

Luke 5:36-38

36 He told them this parable: "No one tears a patch from a new garment and sews it on an old one. If he does, he will have torn the new garment, and the patch from the new will not match the old.

37 And no one pours new wine into old wineskins. If he does, the new wine will burst the skins, the wine will run out and the wineskins will be ruined. 38 No, new wine must be poured into new wineskins.

- v 21... Who can forgive sins but God alone?

- v 30... Why do you eat with tax collectors and sinners?

- v 33... Why don't your disciples fast as often as we do?

Job 32:18-19

18 For I am full of words, and the spirit within me compels me;

19 inside I am like bottled-up wine, like new wineskins ready to burst.

Isaiah 43:18-19

18 "Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past.

19 See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the desert and streams in the wasteland.

Gal 4:4 - "when the fullness of time was come, God sent forth his son... "

2 Pet 1:21 - "... the prophets wrote as they were moved on by the Holy Spirit."

Luke 1:38 (NIV) - "I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered. "May it be to me as you have said."

Luke 5:39 (NIV) - And no one after drinking old wine wants the new, for he says, 'The old is better.'"

Romans 6:3-4 (NKJV)

3 Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death?

4 Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

1 Cor. 15:31 "...I die daily".

Eph 4:22-24 (NIV)

22 You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires;

23 to be made new in the attitude of your minds;

24 and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.

Ezek. 36:26 – God says I will give you a new heart, and put a new spirit within you

2 Cor. 3:6 – This makes us able ministers of the New Testament

Heb. 10:20 – because we have a new and living way opened for us through the veil

John 3:5 – Jesus describes a new birth

Mark 16:17 – He says believers will speak with new tongues

2 Pet 3:13 – Nevertheless... We look for new heavens and a new earth

Rev 3:12 – Where, God says, He will write on us a new name

Rev 5:9 – And where we will sing a new song

Then He who sat on the throne said,

Rev 21:5 (NKJV) - "Behold, I make all things new."
