THE SEQUENCE FOR THE FALL OF A REPUBLIC

- (1) From bondage to spiritual faith;
- (2) From spiritual faith to great courage;
- (3) From courage to liberty;
- (4) From liberty to abundance;
- (5) From abundance to complacency;
- (6) From complacency to apathy;
- (7) From apathy to dependence;
- (8) From dependence back into bondage.

Psalms 42:11 - Why are you downcast, O my soul? Why so disturbed within me? Put your hope in God, for I will yet praise him, my Savior and my God.

Psalm 139:1-6

- 1. O LORD, you have searched me and you know me.
- 2. You know when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar.
- 3. You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways.
- 4. Before a word is on my tongue you know it completely, O LORD.
- 5. You hem me in--behind and before; you have laid your hand upon me.
- 6. Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain.

1. STOP FRETTING!

Psalms 37:1-2 - Do not fret because of evil men or be envious of those who do wrong; for like the grass they will soon wither, like green plants they will soon die away.

The root for "fret" = "being annoyed or burning with anger because of jealousy toward others."

Psalms 37:25 (NLT) Once I was young, and now I am old. Yet I have never seen the godly abandoned or their children begging for bread.

Psalms 73:1-28

- 1. Surely God is good to Israel, to those who are pure in heart.
- 2. But as for me, my feet had almost slipped; I had nearly lost my foothold.
- 3. For I envied the arrogant when I saw the prosperity of the wicked.
- 4. They have no struggles; their bodies are healthy and strong.

- 5. They are free from the burdens common to man; they are not plagued by human ills.
- 6. Therefore pride is their necklace; they clothe themselves with violence.
- 7. From their callous hearts comes iniquity; the evil conceits of their minds know no limits.
- 8. They scoff, and speak with malice; in their arrogance they threaten oppression.
- 9. Their mouths lay claim to heaven, and their tongues take possession of the earth.
- 10. Therefore their people turn to them and drink up waters in abundance.
- 11. They say, "How can God know? Does the Most High have knowledge?"
- 12. This is what the wicked are like-- always carefree, they increase in wealth.
- 13. Surely in vain have I kept my heart pure; in vain have I washed my hands in innocence.
- 14. All day long I have been plagued; I have been punished every morning.
- 15. If I had said, "I will speak thus," I would have betrayed your children.
- 16. When I tried to understand all this, it was oppressive to me
- 17. till I entered the sanctuary of God; then I understood their final destiny.
- 18. Surely you place them on slippery ground; you cast them down to ruin.
- 19. How suddenly are they destroyed, completely swept away by terrors!
- 20. As a dream when one awakes, so when you arise, O Lord, you will despise them as fantasies.
- 21. When my heart was grieved and my spirit embittered,
- 22. I was senseless and ignorant; I was a brute beast before you.
- 23. Yet I am always with you; you hold me by my right hand.
- 24. You guide me with your counsel, and afterward you will take me into glory.
- 25. Whom have I in heaven but you? And earth has nothing I desire besides you.
- 26. My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.
- 27. Those who are far from you will perish; you destroy all who are unfaithful to you.
- 28. But as for me, it is good to be near God. I have made the Sovereign LORD my refuge; I will tell of all your deeds.

2. START TRUSTING!

Psalms 37:3a (NKJV) Trust in the Lord, and do good;

- Vs.7 Be still before the LORD and wait patiently for him; do not fret when men succeed in their ways, when they carry out their wicked schemes.
- Vs.12 The wicked plot against the righteous and gnash their teeth at them;
- Vs.14 The wicked draw the sword and bend the bow to bring down the poor and needy, to slay those whose ways are upright.
- Vs.16 Better the little that the righteous have than the wealth of many wicked;
- Vs.35 I have seen a wicked and ruthless man flourishing like a green tree in its native soil,
- Psalms 23:1 The LORD is my shepherd, I shall not be in want (lack, neediness)
