

When God Wrote With His Own Finger!

I. The first finger of God wrote the moral law (10 Commandments)

Full 10 Commandments found in Exodus 20:1-21

Deuteronomy 9:10 - The Lord gave me two stone tablets inscribed by the finger of God. On them were all the commandments the Lord proclaimed to you on the mountain out of the fire, on the day of the assembly.

Don't have any other gods before me.

Don't make idols.

Don't misuse the Name of the Lord your God.

Remember the Sabbath to keep it holy or set apart.

Don't dishonor or disrespect you father and mother.

Don't murder.

Don't commit adultery.

Don't steal.

Don't lie.

Don't covet.

Romans 3:23 – "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."

II. The second finger of God wrote judgment.

In Daniel 5:1-30 you can read about King Belshazzar.

Hebrews 10:31 – "It is a dreadful thing to fall into the hands of the living God."

Daniel 5:23 - Instead, you have set yourself up against the Lord of heaven. You had the goblets from his temple brought to you, and you and your nobles, your wives and your concubines drank wine from them. You praised the gods of silver and gold, of bronze, iron, wood and stone, which cannot see or hear or understand. But you did not honor the God who holds in his hand your life and all your ways.

Romans 6:23 – “The wages of sin is death...”

Hebrews 9:27 – “It is appointed unto man once to die and after that the judgment.”

Daniel 5:30 - That very night Belshazzar, king of the Babylonians, was slain.

III. The third finger of God wrote grace.

John 8:1-11

1 but Jesus went to the Mount of Olives.

2 At dawn he appeared again in the temple courts, where all the people gathered around him, and he sat down to teach them.

3 The teachers of the law and the Pharisees brought in a woman caught in adultery. They made her stand before the group

4 and said to Jesus, “Teacher, this woman was caught in the act of adultery.

5 In the Law Moses commanded us to stone such women. Now what do you say?”

6 They were using this question as a trap, in order to have a basis for accusing him. But Jesus bent down and started to write on the ground with his finger.

7 When they kept on questioning him, he straightened up and said to them, “Let any one of you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her.”

8 Again he stooped down and wrote on the ground.

9 At this, those who heard began to go away one at a time, the older ones first, until only Jesus was left, with the woman still standing there.

10 Jesus straightened up and asked her, “Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?”

11 “No one, sir,” she said. “Then neither do I condemn you,” Jesus declared. “Go now and leave your life of sin.”

Romans 6:23 – “For the wages of sin is death, BUT THE GIFT OF GOD IS ETERNAL LIFE THROUGH JESUS CHRIST OUR LORD.”

I John 1:9 – “If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just...”

John 8:11

10 Jesus straightened up and asked her, “Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?”

11 “No one, sir,” she said. “Then neither do I condemn you,” Jesus declared. “Go now and leave your life of sin.”

1 John 1:9 - If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
