Who Is This?

Mt. 21:10-11

- 10. When Jesus entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred and asked, "Who is this?"
- 11. The crowds answered, "This is Jesus, the prophet from Nazareth in Galilee."
- Mk. 4:41 They were terrified and asked each other, "Who is this? Even the wind and the waves obey him!"

Lk. 5:20-21

- 20. When Jesus saw their faith, he said, "Friend, your sins are forgiven."
- 21. The Pharisees and the teachers of the law began thinking to themselves, "Who is this fellow who speaks blasphemy? Who can forgive sins but God alone?"

Lk. 7:47-49

- 47. Therefore, I tell you, her many sins have been forgiven--for she loved much. But he who has been forgiven little loves little."
- 48. Then Jesus said to her, "Your sins are forgiven."
- 49. The other guests began to say among themselves, "Who is this who even forgives sins?"

Jn. 5:8-12

- 8. Then Jesus said to him, "Get up! Pick up your mat and walk."
- 9. At once the man was cured; he picked up his mat and walked. The day on which this took place was a Sabbath,
- 10. and so the Jews said to the man who had been healed, "It is the Sabbath; the law forbids you to carry your mat."
- 11. But he replied, "The man who made me well said to me, `Pick up your mat and walk.'"
- 12. So they asked him, "Who is this fellow who told you to pick it up and walk?"

Jn. 12:32-34

- 32. But I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to myself."
- 33. He said this to show the kind of death he was going to die.
- 34. The crowd spoke up, "We have heard from the Law that the Christ will remain forever, so how can you say, `The Son of Man must be lifted up'? Who is this `Son of Man'?"

Isaiah 9:6-7

- 6. For unto us a <u>child is born</u>, unto us a <u>son is given</u>: and the <u>government</u> shall be <u>upon</u> his shoulder: and his <u>name</u> shall be <u>called Wonderful</u>, <u>Counselor</u>, <u>The mighty God</u>, the <u>everlasting Father</u>, The <u>Prince of Peace</u>.
- 7. Of the <u>increase</u> of his <u>government and peace</u> there will be no <u>end</u>. He will reign on David's throne and over his <u>kingdom</u>, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever. The zeal of the LORD Almighty will accomplish this.
- **I.** He begins vs. 6 with "for unto us". We are the reason for the Universe! He created us so that we could have the opportunity to experience God's love!
- II. "A Child is born" His humanity (Incarnation)
- **III.** "A Son is Given" His divinity (*Crucifixion*)
- **IV.** "and the government (Empire, kingdom, Kings domain) shall be (Carried) upon his shoulder" His ascendancy, sovereignty and supreme authority (**Resurrection**)
- Colossians. 3:1 Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God.
- Heb. 2:14,15 Since the children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might destroy him who holds the power of death--that is, the devil--and free those who all their lives were held in slavery by their fear of death.
- **V.** "and His <u>Name</u>"- honor, authority, character, what sets one apart Proverbs 22:1a A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, Church Ekklesia called out ones
- **VI.** "shall be <u>Called</u>" = published, read about, pronounced, Cried unto, invited, declared, preached, proclaimed, made famous and renowned.
- 1. Wonderful = pele' (peh'-leh) a miracle, a marvel, extraordinary, remarkable, amazing.
- 2. Counselor = ya'ats (yaw-ats'); adviser; deliberator, one who resolves, lawyer, advocate, sustainer, consultant, guide, originator, one who gives purpose.

- 3. Mighty God = gibbor /El = Almighty, powerful, warrior God who excels in everything and cannot lose.
- 4. Everlasting Father = aw-gan' perpetual, eternal, one who stays, faithful in marriage, without end.

5. Prince of Peace

- a. Prince = sar head, boss, chief, director, commander, master, ruler and administrator.
- b. shalom safety, wellness, happiness, health, prosperity, peacefulness, wholeness.
- "Of the <u>increase</u> of his <u>government</u> (Empire, kingdom, Kings domain) <u>and peace</u> (safety, wellness, happiness, health, prosperity, peacefulness, wholeness) there will be no <u>end</u>.(border, boundary, limit, after)"
