

## **You Can't Keep A Captive's Chains When You Have A Deliverer's Destiny!**

You are either a captive or a deliverer!

Ps. 107:8-14

8. Let them give thanks to the LORD for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for men,

9. for he satisfies the thirsty and fills the hungry with good things.

10. Some sat in darkness and the deepest gloom, prisoners suffering in iron chains,

11. for they had rebelled against the words of God and despised the counsel of the Most High.

12. So he subjected them to bitter labor; they stumbled, and there was no one to help.

13. Then they cried to the LORD in their trouble, and he saved them from their distress.

14. He brought them out of darkness and the deepest gloom and broke away their chains.

Ps. 116:16 - O LORD, truly I am your servant; I am your servant, the son of your maidservant ; you have freed me from my chains.

Acts 12:6-7

6. The night before Herod was to bring him to trial, Peter was sleeping between two soldiers, bound with two chains, and sentries stood guard at the entrance.

7. Suddenly an angel of the Lord appeared and a light shone in the cell. He struck Peter on the side and woke him up. "Quick, get up!" he said, and the chains fell off Peter's wrists.

Acts 16:25-26

25. About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening to them.

26. Suddenly there was such a violent earthquake that the foundations of the prison were shaken. At once all the prison doors flew open, and everybody's chains came loose.

Luke 9:12 then he called his twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all devils and to cure diseases and he sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.

Romans 1:16 for I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God unto salvation.

Isaiah 58:6 - ..."loose the chains of injustice and untie the cords of the yoke, to set the oppressed free and break every yoke"!

We are commissioned to loose the chains those who are bound!

Lk. 13:10-13

10. On a Sabbath Jesus was teaching in one of the synagogues,
11. and a woman was there who had been crippled by a spirit for eighteen years. She was bent over and could not straighten up at all.
12. When Jesus saw her, he called her forward and said to her, "Woman, you are set free from your infirmity."
13. Then he put his hands on her, and immediately she straightened up and praised God.

John 8:32 - Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

2 Corinthians 5:21 - God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

Isaiah 53:10-12

10. Yet it was the LORD's will to crush him and cause him to suffer, and though the LORD makes his life a guilt offering, he will see his offspring and prolong his days, and the will of the LORD will prosper in his hand.
11. After the suffering of his soul, he will see the light [of life] and be satisfied ; by his knowledge my righteous servant will justify many, and he will bear their iniquities.
12. Therefore I will give him a portion among the great, and he will divide the spoils with the strong, because he poured out his life unto death, and was numbered with the transgressors. For he bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

Your debt has been paid in full!

Satan's dominion over you has ended!

Colossians 1:13 - For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves.

Matthew 8:16-17

16. When evening came, many who were demon-possessed were brought to him, and he drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick.

17. This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: "He took up our infirmities and carried our diseases."

Isaiah 53:5 - But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed.

1 Peter 2:24 - He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by his wounds you have been healed.

The first Adam brought the double curse of sin and sickness... The last Adam, Jesus, brought the double cure salvation for the spirit and soul and healing for the body!

1Cor. 4:20 - For the kingdom of God is not a matter of talk but of power.

The Gospel is the power to accomplish... It's power to conduct Kingdom business!

Hebrews 13:8 - Jesus Christ the same yesterday today and forever.

The same resurrection power that raised Jesus from the dead lives in us!

Rom. 8:11 - And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit, who lives in you.

Lk. 4:18-19

18. "The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to release the oppressed,

19. to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor."

The same anointing that was on Jesus is now on us!

1 John 3:8 - He who does what is sinful is of the devil, because the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil's work.

He was the son of God manifested to destroy the works of the devil... Now we are the sons of God manifested to destroy the works of the devil!

Romans 8:19 - The creation waits in eager expectation for the sons of God to be revealed. (manifested)

Luke 17:20-21

20. Once, having been asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, Jesus replied, "The kingdom of God does not come with your careful observation,

21. nor will people say, 'Here it is,' or 'There it is,' because the kingdom of God is within you."

The Holy Spirit was given to us to empower us to manifest the kingdom of God in this earth...

To overthrow Satan's kingdom!

Isaiah 10:27 - In that day their burden will be lifted from your shoulders, their yoke from your neck; the yoke will be broken because you have grown so fat.

KJV - And it shall come to pass in that day that his burden should be taken away from off the shoulder and his yoke from off by Neck and the yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing.

Acts 10:38 - how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power, and how he went around doing good and healing all who were under the power of the devil, because God was with him.
